Abstract Submission

Participation in VIBCON-2019 is open to all scientists, faculty members, research students, who are working in the field of Veterinary Immunology, Animal Biotechnology and related disciplines. Abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation should be in a maximum of 300 words including the title, authors, and address. Abstracts should be prepared in MSWord, Times New Roman, 12 font size, and single space leaving 1" margin on the left and right sides of a page. The e-mail ID and affiliation of the presenting author must be clearly given in the abstract and in the registration application. The abstract should be submitted **in electronic form only** on or before **21st December 2019** as an e-mail attachment to vibcon2019@gmail.com/malikyps@gmail.com. *The acceptance will be communicated to the presenting author through e-mail only.*

Accommodation
