The abstract should be limited to 300 words typed in 12 font size (Times New Roman, Microsoft word) in 1.5 line spacing, leaving 1" margin on all sides. The abstract should contain the objectives of the study, brief methodology, results and conclusions. Selected papers will be considered for oral or poster presentation. The name of the presenting author should be marked in bold and underlined. Authors' names and affiliations should be clearly stated. The acceptance for the selected abstracts will be communicated to the presenting author through e-mail only.
