

College of Veterinary Science (Ludhiana and Rampura Phul Campus), College of Dairy Science and Technology, College of Fisheries, College of Animal Biotechnology and Veterinary Polytechnic College, Kaljharani along with three Regional Livestock Research & Training Centres and Krishi Vigyan Kendras. The University has two affiliated colleges (Khalsa College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Amritsar and Baba Hira Das Ji College of Veterinary Pharmacy, Badal, Sri Muktsar Sahib). The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has accredited the University with 'A' grade, and ranked First among the Indian State Veterinary Universities during the year 2019-20.

Abstract Submission

Participation in VIBCON is open to all scientists, faculty members, research students, who are working in the field of Veterinary Immunology, Animal Biotechnology and related disciplines. Abstracts for Oral/Poster presentation should be in a maximum of 300 words including the title, authors, and address. Abstracts should be prepared in MS Word, Times New Roman, 12 font size, and single space leaving 1" margin on the left and right sides of page. The e-mail ID and affiliation of the presenting author must be clearly given in the abstract and in the registration application (Please Follow Template Attached). The abstract should be submitted in electronic form only on or before 20th January 2021 as an e-mail attachment to vibcon2021 @gmail.com. The acceptance will be communicated to the presenting author through e-mail only by 25th January, 2022.

Accommodation

A very limited number of accommodations are available in the institute guest houses and in the nearby Govt. institutes / organizations. Therefore, the delegates will be provided accommodation in the hotels located in the city. The approximate tariffs for hotel accommodation are ranging from ₹ 1500.00 to 3500.00 per day. Preferably, the Hotel booking may be made directly by the participants. On request, the hotel accommodation may be reserved on receipt of the advance payment to "Organising Secretary, VIBCON". Limited accommodation (on payment basis) is also available in Guest Houses (for faculty) and Farmer's Hostels (for students) of GADVASU and Punjab Agricultural University (PAU), Ludhiana on first come first serve basis (subject to prior registration along with fee).

Travel Information

The city is located approximately 320 km from New Delhi and 100 km from Chandigarh. The nearest airport is Chandigarh Airport, officially known as Shaheed-e-Azam Bhagat Singh Airport Mohali. The various private taxi services are available directly from airport to Ludhiana. The distance from Ludhiana Junction Railway station (station code: LDH) and Bus Stand to University Campus is about 5 km which can be easily covered by frequent taxi or autorickshaw services.

Weather Condition in Ludhiana

The weather in Ludhiana is generally pleasant in February with moderate cold (Day temperature around 20°C, Night temperature around 8-10°C. Participants are advised to bring light woollen garments.
